Mr Anshu Kaushal, IITian former scientist ISRO, former Intern Loughborough University guided our students on the topic 'How to crack

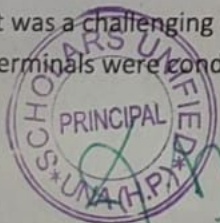
IIT and other entrance Exams.


Dr Sanjeev Sharma, a renowned prof. From JNU University gave a lecture on 'Environment Friendly Living.'

It was a challenging task for the school to evaluate the student's performance in studies. The terminals were conducted online for the classes. Many online PTM's helped in implementation of re




